

Challenge 5: What do you think of when you look up?

English: Inspired by 'Katie and the Starry Night' by James Mayhew and How to Catch a Star by Oliver Jeffers

Art: create own version of 'The Starry Night' by Vincent van Gogh, Oil/Acrylic technique

Music: Looking at 'Starry Starry Night' by Don McClean and the Planets Suite by Gustav Holst.

Challenge 4: Are little green men real?

English: Inspired by 'There's an Alien in your book' and There's an Elf in Your Book!

Fiction: Creation of our own 'There's an Alien...' book- writing instructions to the reader.

Poetry: What do aliens look like? Based on 'Question Time' poem.

Nonfiction/Science: learning about planets in the solar system that may support life.

Art: designing our own alien friend

Challenge 6: Anyone fancy a holiday in the stars?


English: Nonfiction books about space

Report writing and factfiles about the planets in the Solar System

History: The Moon Landing and the Space Race

Science: Scale models of the Solar System. Discovering the properties of materials and considering what materials would make a good space craft/ space suit.

Technology/Current affairs: Looking into space tourism and moon bases.



Challenge 7: Shall we have the best party on Earth?

English: Reading recipes, nonfiction reading, Dia de Los Muertos book

Geography/Culture: What is Halloween like in different countries? What is Dia De Los Muertos and how is it different to Halloween?

Design: Designing our own decorations for a party

History: How has the way we celebrate changed over the years? How has technology changed this?

Drama/Music: Preparing for the Christmas production

Subjects also taught discretely: Spanish, PE, computing and maths.
